A leader is someone who...



Being a pillar for the community



- Make sure everyone feels **supported** and has the **opportunity** to contribute
- Create a **friendly** and **welcoming** environment
- Ensure the community **stays true to its values and goals**
- *Keep it up, even if things get slow*

Hone your reflection skills



- Take time to look at how you're approaching things and how you can improve
- *"leadership is a continuous journey of improvement, not a destination."*

Inspire future leaders



- Create leadership **opportunities**
- Recognize and amplify **emerging talent**
- **Be transparent** about the challenges you've overcome

Know how to Collaborate and Delegate



- Prevent **burnout** - both for yourself and others
- Don't think you're *the one* that has to do *that thing*
- Aim for **distributed responsibility** to avoid single points of failure

Communities need you!

- Each of us has something to offer: **time, skills, a different perspective**, etc.
- Find a community that **aligns with** your interests and with what you're passionate about
- Start contributing in the way you feel most comfortable (important: **it doesn't necessarily have to be writing code!**)
